#### **GOALS**

## → Successfully and steadily connect with friends without physically meeting them

## → Using Discord

#### → Twitter and Facebook groups



Using Discord is fun and fairly easy once one gets used to the interface. Also, my motivation to use it is fairly high because I feel safe interacting in my private servers with my close friends, or observing public servers of a shared interest.

## **Motivating Factors**

- → Feeling of belonging (with friends and community acquaintances)
- → Feeling of being part of an 'underground' network with lots of freedom of expression
- → Love for innovative, speedy technology

## **Inhibiting Factors**

- → Busy schedules make for less time to connect and interact on Discord servers.
- → Presence is not nearly as strong when I'm merely lurking rather than interacting.

## **Possible Triggers**

- → A new game is released, which may get me motivated to play it or talk about it in servers.
- → I, or a friend, want a private platform to talk or vent about our days.



#### **GOALS**

→ Connect with photography and writing communities

Cindy wants to be more in-the-loop with her favorite photographers, artists, and authors. She also wants to discover new communitites of like-minded enthusiasts.

→ Stay connected with friends/family in her country of residence and country of origin

She wants to be able to keep in touch with friends and family who live closeby in the UK, but also connect with those in who live in Cambodia—the other side of the world.

→ SNS, WhatsApp


If all else fails, she can use text and easy-to-use platforms like WhatsApp to connect with friends and family abroad.

# MOTIVATION VS ABILITY

## **Motivation vs Ability Chart**



Discord is a moderate adjustment for her due to her knowing how to work computers but not being familiar with the platform environment and interface. However, she is moderately motivated to use it to connect with close people and people who share her interests.

## **Motivating Factors**

- → Feeling of belonging (with friends, family, and community acquaintances).
- → Her love for photography and knowing that there are photography communities out there.
- → Wanting to try and learn something new from her connections.

## **Inhibiting Factors**

- → Busy schedules and vastly different time-zones make it difficult for her to connect with her abroad friends and family.
- → She is not necessarily a gamer (only knows games on her smartphone).
- → Although the demographics are changing, Discord having the reputation of being predominantly white male gamers may turn her away.

## **Possible Triggers**

- → Some of the people she follows online advertise these platforms for more community engagement.
- → Meeting people who say they use Discord.

The friends she made while in the UK as well as friends back in Cambodia are her main driving force. Some of them are gamers but others, like her, are not but still use Discord for the easy connection.

#### **FAMILY**


Her family in the UK as well as in Cambodia motivate her to find new and interesting ways to connect with them.
